### The role as School Nurse

We are seeking a School Nurse who is passionate about achieving outcomes for children and students and who will cater for their needs and wellbeing.

The school nurse will be responsible for coordinating and overseeing health visits and consultations for the pupils, including in-school vaccinations. Their responsibilities will include providing training for teaching staff, screening for younger pupils, hold the position as Designated Safeguarding Lead and be part of the school's welfare team led by the Headteacher. This includes some ad-hoc administration duties such as assisting with updates of relevant policies.

### Who are we looking for?

The successful candidate will be a registered nurse and ideally have experience as a school nurse. They should also have a passion for working with children, young people and have a comprehensive understanding of safeguarding children and young people. He or she must have the ability and sufficient level of experience to work autonomously, and have excellent interpersonal, communication and organisational skills.

Experience of working as a school nurse is desired, as is the ability to speak and understand Swedish. Emphasis will also be put on the candidates' personal traits as we are keen to find the right staff member to join our team.

### Terms of employment

- Part-time (70%) with an immediate start or in mid-August, subject to agreement with the successful candidate.
- Permanent position after the successful completion of a 6 months probationary period for a candidate who has the right to work in the UK.
- Competitive individual salary structure
- The school will sponsor and pay for a three-year work visa if required
- Traveling and moving allowance for candidates hired from outside the UK.
