The Role

- Hold a teaching qualification in relevant subjects and age groups.
- Have at least three years of relevant experience of successfully teaching English at GCSE level. Experience teaching A-levels is desirable, as is previous work experience from international schools.
- Is a confident, adaptable classroom practitioner with high expectations and a strong ability to engage, motivate and challenge pupils.
- Use formative and summative assessment effectively to support learning.
- Work well as a team player, taking initiative and sharing expertise.
- Is digitally competent, with experience in Google Education's classroom learning environment, which is a plus.
- Is fluent in Swedish and English, ideally to a native level.
- Has an existing right to work in the UK (desirable but not required).



- Qualified to teach Civics or other subjects in the Swedish curriculum (desirable but not required)

What We Offer

Work Visa & Sponsorship:

- The candidate must cover visa costs for any accompanying family members.
