The Role

We are looking for two dedicated Science Teachers to teach a combination of Biology, Chemistry, General Science ("Naturkunskap", Physics and Mathematics. These full-time positions start on 15 August 2025. For the right applicant, there may be an opportunity to combine teaching with a part-time management role in the Sixth Form.

- Use formative and summative assessment effectively to support learning.
- Work well as team players, taking initiative and sharing expertise.
- Are digitally competent—experience with SchoolSoft and Google Classroom is a plus.
- Are fluent in Swedish and have at least B2-level English proficiency.
- Have an existing right to work in the UK (desirable but not required).
- Have an interest in programming and AI (desirable).



What We Offer

Work Visa & Sponsorship:

- The Swedish School in London sponsors successful candidates for a **three-year work visa**, covering visa costs for the teacher.
- Candidates must cover visa costs for any accompanying family members.

Relocation Support:

- A travel and moving allowance for hires from outside the UK.
- Basic guidance on moving to the UK.

Salary & Terms of Employment:

- Full-time contract **starting 15 August 2025**.
- One school year probation, if successful, another two years employment. In total, a three-year fixed-term contract.
- Individual salary structure, based on experience and qualifications.

Your application must be **in English** (due to visa requirements) and include:

- A **cover letter** explaining why you are the right candidate and what subject combination interests you.
- A **comprehensive CV** (with no unexplained gaps).
- **Proof of teaching qualifications**, including subjects covered.
- **Two references** (from the last five years, including one from a manager).
